**Min 224- Planning Applications- Observations**

07/B/1162 – Full Planning Application- Erect extension and detached garage- 7 Mill Hill Chatton. *Members felt this was overdevelopment of the area. The garage is too close to the lime trees and it will damage the roots, the original application for this area did not allow the trees to be touched. This would set a precedent to the area and it would change the character. The proximity of the development would affect the outlook of the neighbouring properties.*

08/B/0043- Renewal of Temporary Consent- Retention of anemometry mast for a further 2 years- Moorland approx 2.9km south east of Chillingham Alnwick Northumberland. *Two members felt there was no need for the renewal of the permission as the mast has been up long enough to assess the weather conditions.*
